
Nebraska Gasoline and Diesel Prices

The state average retail price of gasoline increased 4 cents to \$1.87, and the state average retail diesel price rose 2 cents to \$1.92 per gallon. While crude oil inventories should rebound over the coming weeks from the impact of Hurricane Ivan, the future of petroleum product inventories is a little less clear.
