
Nebraska Gasoline and Diesel Prices

A record high was set again this week in North Platte at \$2.11 per gallon. Nebraska's average retail price of gasoline had no change from last week remaining at \$2.01 with metro prices ranging from \$1.94 in Columbus to \$2.08 in North Platte. This week Midwest gasoline stock levels eased back into the normal range.

Nebraska's metro diesel prices ranged from \$2.05 in Columbus to \$2.25 in Kearney resulting in the state average increasing 4 cents to \$2.20 per gallon. All seven of the metro areas again set new record high levels this week while Midwest distillate fuel inventories fell below the normal range.
