
Nebraska Gasoline and Diesel Prices

Nebraska's average retail price of gasoline remains at \$2.01 for the third consecutive week with metro prices ranging from \$1.93 in Columbus to \$2.07 in North Platte. Midwest gasoline stock levels are in the normal range.

Nebraska's metro diesel prices ranged from \$2.09 in Columbus to \$2.21 in Kearney with the state average falling 2 cents to \$2.18 per gallon. The only record high this week was in Columbus with the price of \$2.17 on November 2. Midwest distillate fuel inventories eased into the bottom of the normal range.
