Nebraska Gasoline and Diesel Prices

Nebraska's average retail price of gasoline fell 2 cents to \$1.92 with metro prices ranging from \$1.87 in Columbus to \$1.98 in Kearney and North Platte. Midwest gasoline stock levels remain in the normal range.

Nebraska's metro diesel prices ranged from \$2.05 in Norfolk to \$2.13 in North Platte with the state average increasing a penny to \$2.11 per gallon. Midwest distillate fuel inventories increased but remain below the normal range.
