## **Nebraska Gasoline and Diesel Prices**

### **Motor Gasoline**

For the week of January 14, Nebraska's average gasoline price fell nine cents to \$3.05, which was 92 cents higher than the price at this time last year. Weekly averages in the surveyed cities ranged from \$3.00 in Norfolk to \$3.05 in Lincoln. As of January 11, the Midwest gasoline stock level was just below the bottom boundary of the normal range with 51.1 million barrels.

#### **Diesel Fuel**

This week the price of diesel fuel in the state had decreased five cents to \$3.38. According to the <u>weekly price report</u>, this week's state average was 82 cents higher than the price at this time last year. Weekly averages in the surveyed cities ranged from \$3.29 in North Platte to \$3.41 in Norfolk. On the supply side, the Midwest distillate fuel inventory level was in the bottom half of the normal range with 21.7 million barrels of ultra-low sulfur diesel fuel and 5.8 million barrels of low sulfur diesel fuel as of January 11.


#### Notes

Regular unleaded gasoline is regular unleaded motor gasoline with an 87 to 88 octane. Diesel fuel is fuel used for internal combustion in diesel engines. Ultra-low sulfur diesel fuel has sulfur levels of 15 ppm and less while low sulfur diesel fuel ranges from more-than-15 ppm to 500 ppm sulfur.




A general rule of thumb: A dollar increase in the West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude oil price per barrel will result in a 2.5-cent increase in the gasoline price per gallon and the diesel fuel price per gallon. Likewise, a dollar decrease in the WTI crude oil price per barrel will result in a 2.5-cent decrease in the gasoline price per gallon and the diesel fuel price per gallon.
