

## Nebraska Gasoline and Diesel Prices

### Motor Gasoline

For the week of February 4, Nebraska's average gasoline price rose five cents to \$3.01, which was 80 cents higher than the price at this time last year. Weekly averages in the surveyed cities ranged from \$2.91 in Columbus to \$3.05 in North Platte. As of February 1, the Midwest gasoline stock level was in the normal range with 54.4 million barrels.

### Diesel Fuel

This week the price of diesel fuel in the state had increased two cents to \$3.33. According to the [weekly price report](#), this week's state average was 80 cents higher than the price at this time last year. Weekly averages in the surveyed cities ranged from \$3.27 in Lincoln to \$3.37 in Norfolk. On the supply side, the Midwest distillate fuel inventory level was in the normal range with 22.5 million barrels of ultra-low sulfur diesel fuel and 6 million barrels of low sulfur diesel fuel as of February 1.

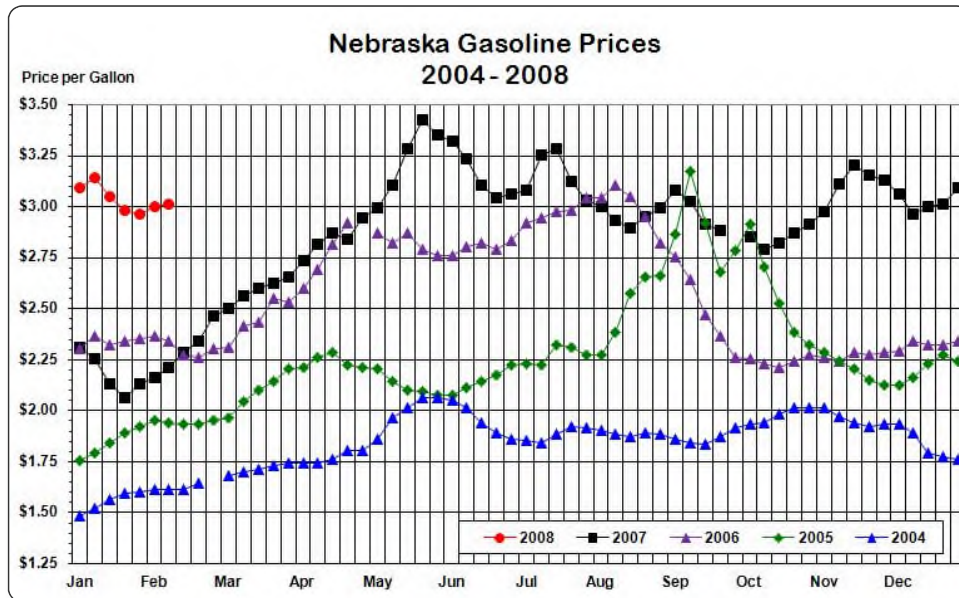
### Notes

Regular unleaded gasoline is regular unleaded motor gasoline with an 87 to 88 octane. Diesel fuel is fuel used for internal combustion in diesel engines. Ultra-low sulfur diesel fuel has sulfur levels of 15 ppm and less while low sulfur diesel fuel ranges from more-than-15 ppm to 500 ppm sulfur.

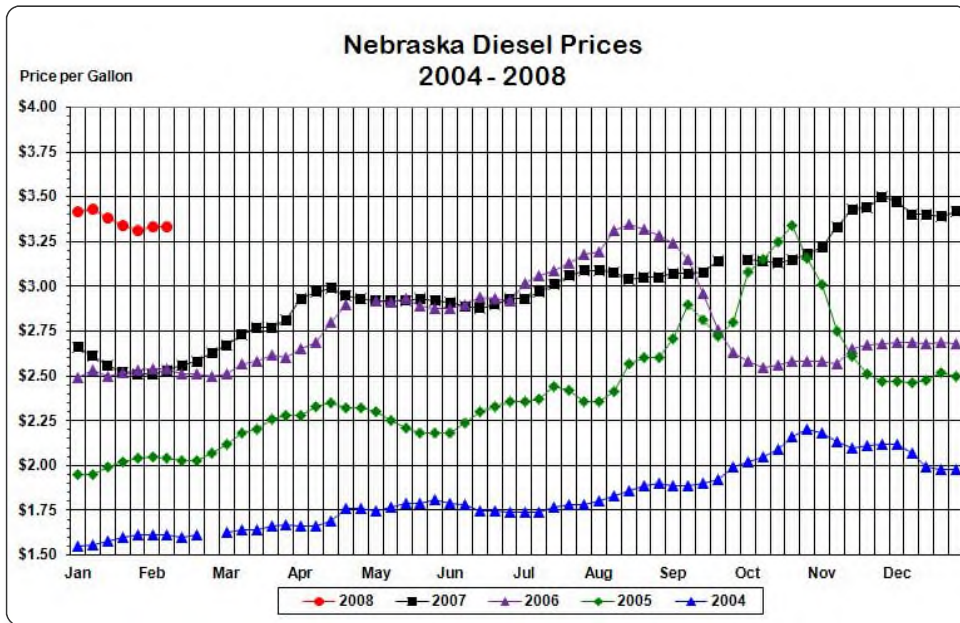
A general rule of thumb: A dollar increase in the [West Texas Intermediate](#) (WTI) crude oil price per barrel will result in a 2.5-cent increase in the gasoline price per gallon and the diesel fuel price per gallon. Likewise, a dollar decrease in the WTI crude oil price per barrel will result in a 2.5-cent decrease in the gasoline price per gallon and the diesel fuel price per gallon.
