

Nebraska Gasoline and Diesel Prices

Motor Gasoline

For the week of September 21, Nebraska's average gasoline price had increased one cent from the last report to \$2.53, which was \$1.05 lower than the price at this time last year. Weekly averages in the surveyed cities ranged from \$2.45 in Grand Island to \$2.67 in North Platte. As of September 18, the Midwest gasoline stock level was in the upper half of the normal range with 51.4 million barrels.

Diesel Fuel

The average price of diesel fuel in the state had fallen one cent from the last report to \$2.63. According to the [weekly price report](#), this week's state average was \$1.33 lower than the price at this time last year. Weekly averages in the surveyed cities ranged from \$2.59 in Norfolk to \$2.65 in Grand Island and Kearney. On the supply side, the Midwest distillate fuel inventory level was above the normal range with 28 million barrels of ultra-low sulfur diesel fuel and 3.1 million barrels of low sulfur diesel fuel as of September 18.

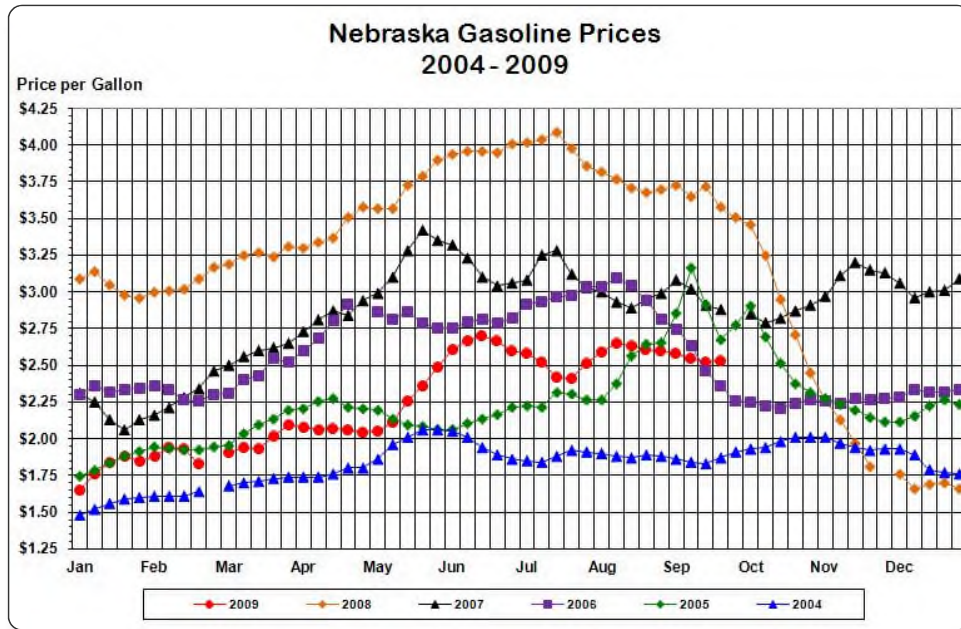
Notes

Regular unleaded gasoline is regular unleaded motor gasoline with an 87 to 88 octane. Diesel fuel is fuel used for internal combustion in diesel engines. Ultra-low sulfur diesel fuel has sulfur levels of 15 ppm and less while low sulfur diesel fuel ranges from more-than-15 ppm to 500 ppm sulfur.

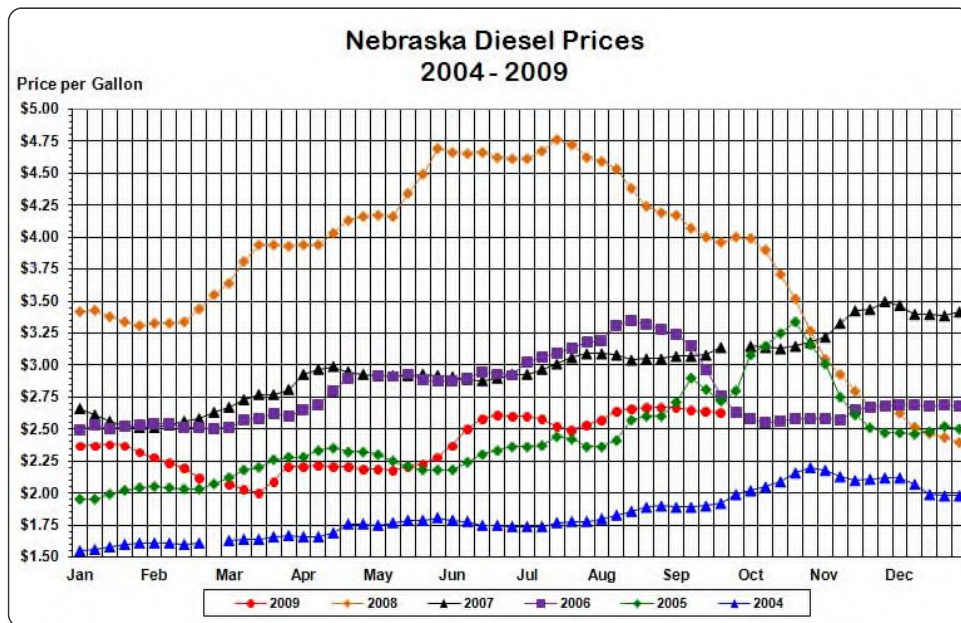
A general rule of thumb: A dollar increase in the [West Texas Intermediate](#) (WTI) crude oil price per barrel will result in a 2.5-cent increase in the gasoline price per gallon and the diesel fuel price per gallon. Likewise, a dollar decrease in the WTI crude oil price per barrel will result in a 2.5-cent decrease in the gasoline price per gallon and the diesel fuel price per gallon.
