

## Nebraska Gasoline and Diesel Prices

### Motor Gasoline

For the week of July 4, 2011, Nebraska's average gasoline price had risen 3 cents from the last report to \$3.60, which was 82 cents higher than the price at this time last year. Weekly averages in the surveyed cities ranged from \$3.58 in Omaha to \$3.69 in Kearney. As of July 1, total inventory of all grades of gasoline in the Midwest region was in the lower half of the normal range.

### Diesel Fuel

The average price of diesel fuel in the state had fallen 3 cents from the last report to \$3.83. According to the [weekly price report](#), this week's state average was 93 cents higher than the price at this time last year. Weekly averages in the surveyed cities ranged from \$3.79 in Lincoln to \$3.86 in Grand Island and North Platte. On the supply side, the Midwest distillate fuel inventory level was below the normal range with 25 million barrels of ultra-low sulfur diesel fuel and 1.3 million barrels of low sulfur diesel fuel as of July 1.

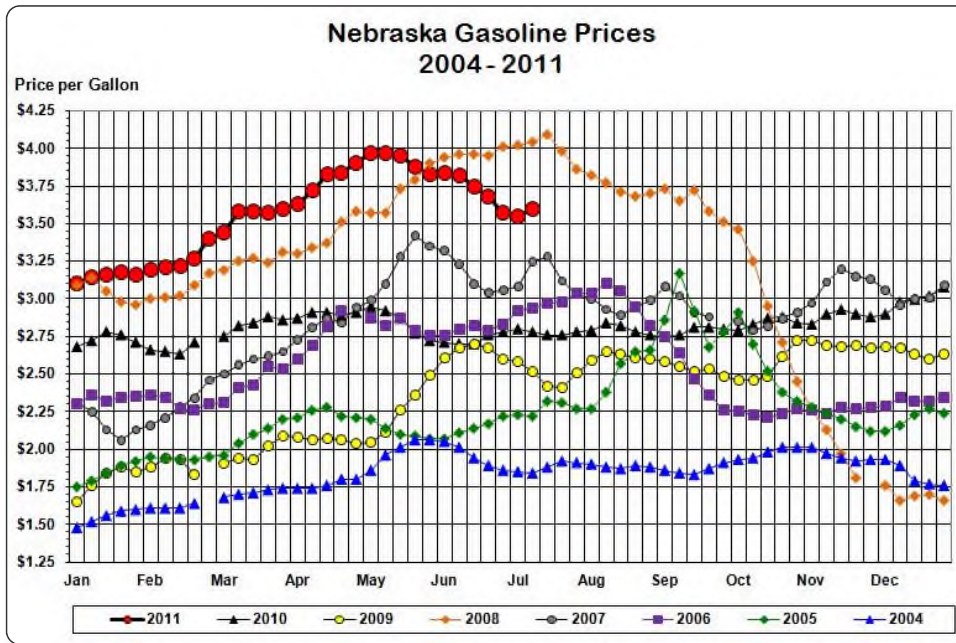
### Notes

Regular unleaded gasoline is regular unleaded motor gasoline with an 87 to 88 octane. Diesel fuel is fuel used for internal combustion in diesel engines. Ultra-low sulfur diesel fuel has sulfur levels of 15 ppm and less while low sulfur diesel fuel ranges from more-than-15 ppm to 500 ppm sulfur.

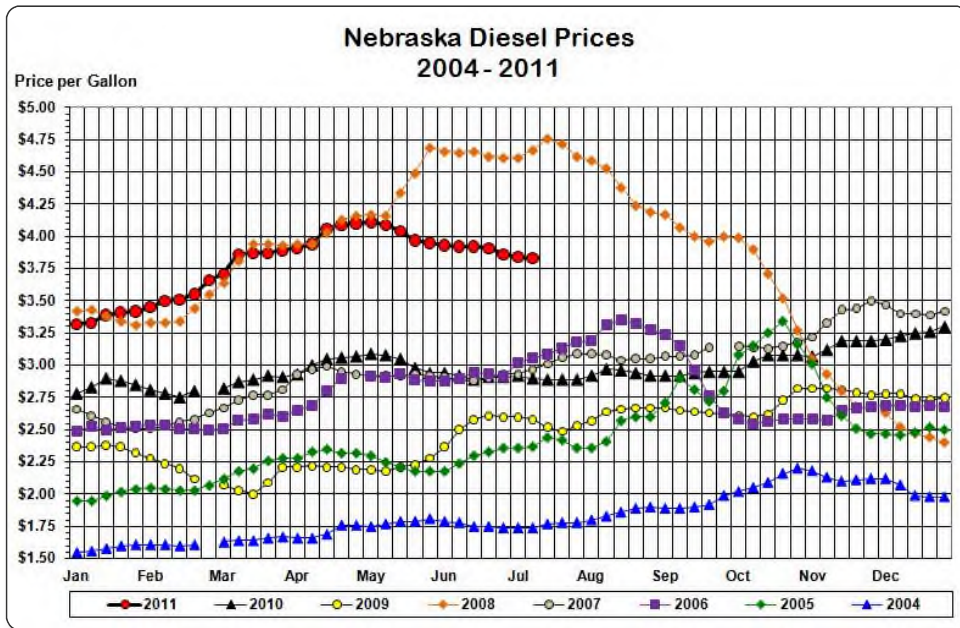
A general rule of thumb: A dollar increase in the [West Texas Intermediate](#) (WTI) crude oil price per barrel will result in a 2.5-cent increase in the gasoline price per gallon and the diesel fuel price per gallon. Likewise, a dollar decrease in the WTI crude oil price per barrel will result in a 2.5-cent decrease in the gasoline price per gallon and the diesel fuel price per gallon.
