

## Add .mobi book to Kindle Fire HDX

### Kindle Fire HDX

1. Save the **.mobi** file to a convenient location on your Vista/Windows 7 computer, such as the desktop.
2. Attach your device to your computer using a micro-USB cable.
  - a. You may have to locate your own. Apparently Amazon may/may not have included a micro-USB cable. Micro-USB cable availability depends on the Kindle version you purchased & if it was bundled with any "extras."
3. Wait for your computer to recognize the device, then right-click **Start**.
4. Click **Windows Explorer/File Explorer**.

**Note:** In some cases, it may be necessary to unlock the Kindle Fire before your computer recognizes the device.
5. Under Portable Devices, double-click **Fire**.
6. Double-click **Internal storage**.
7. Double-click **Books** and move the window aside.
8. Find the **.mobi** file you saved in **Step 1**, drag-and-drop it into the device's **Books** folder you opened in **Step 7**.
9. Wait for the file transfer to complete and then **safely** eject your Kindle Fire HDX from your computer.
  - a. Windows:...Right-click the Kindle & select "**Safely Remove Mass Storage Device**"
  - b. Mac: .....Select "**Eject**"
10. The e-book should appear on the device's carousel screen.
