

Copy an AZW File to Kindle

The Kindle is a proprietary ebook reader designed and sold by Amazon.com, which uses an e-Ink display to simulate print and paper.

You can transfer your own AWZ ebook files to the Kindle, as long as they don't have any DRM protection.

USB cable

Step 1

Connect the Kindle to your computer using its USB cable. The computer will recognize the Kindle as a mass storage device.

Step 2

Open the Kindle's folder by clicking its icon on the desktop or by opening "My Computer" and clicking its drive letter. Inside will be three folders:

1. "music,"
2. "audible", and
3. "documents."

Step 3

Drag and drop your AWZ ebook files into the Kindle's "**documents**" folder. Once the file transfer is complete, disconnect the Kindle and the AWZ ebooks will be available immediately in the Kindle's library.
